

Important information

By submitting the application, the participant/exhibitor agrees that the data provided for their participation in GPEC[®] 2022 are made available to contracting partners of EMW GmbH. This only applies to contracting partners related directly to GPEC[®] 2022 in Frankfurt am Main.

Part of participating in GPEC[®] 2022 in Frankfurt am Main is the mandatory use of services provided by contracting partners of EMW GmbH and their vicarious agents (e.g. stand building companies, agencies, etc). Concerning the field of exhibition logistics this applies from the arrival of the vehicle on the exhibition grounds Frankfurt and ends with the completed loading of the departing vehicle.

Exhibitor Manual:

Please note the deadlines for the submission of the forms of EMW GmbH (GPEC) and Messe Frankfurt. The forms of Messe Frankfurt must be received no later than 3 weeks before the start of setup. Messe Frankfurt reserves the right to charge an additional fee for late orders.

Shop for Exhibitor Services of Messe Frankfurt

Services provided by Messe Frankfurt GmbH have to be ordered separately. Shortly, you receive a code from Messe Frankfurt for accessing the online Shop for Exhibitor Services. Vehicles as exhibit

Vehicles with combustion engines

- The fuel tank must be locked and nearly empty.
- Vehicles being exhibited may be powered by the starter battery as long as is it ensured that no hazardous gases are produced (e.g. by using gel batteries), the battery contacts are configured such that they are safe to touch, and the starter remains disconnected from the battery.
- The battery is to be disconnected or removed in all other cases.

Vehicles with natural gas propulsion systems

- The gas tanks must have been emptied and depressurised (see also Item 5.7 of the Technical Guidelines of Messe Frankfurt).

Vehicles with alternative drive technologies, e.g. electrically-powered vehicles or hybrid vehicles

- The fuel tank must be locked and nearly empty.
- The drive motor must be disconnected from the battery, e.g. by means of a battery disconnect switch.
- It must be ensured that there is no voltage at the high-voltage battery / the high-voltage battery must be in a typical, non-critical state for a battery.
- Batteries may only be charged in the exhibition halls with the prior agreement of Messe Frankfurt Venue GmbH's Technical Project Management
- The positions of the vehicles within the stand area must be shown on a plan.
- The relevant rescue sheets must be kept at the stand, and are also to be submitted to Messe Frankfurt in advance.
- Vehicles with fuel cells or other drive units are considered separately.

Vehicles on your booth or the outdoor area require permission from Messe Frankfurt and the organizer.

Please use form E16 to inform the organizer about vehicles as exhibit.

A sufficient quantity of suitable extinguishing units/agents for all vehicles is to be kept available at the stand at all times. Messe Frankfurt Venue GmbH reserves the right to require additional measures.

Filming and photography

Both **photography and filming** are **strictly forbidden** in the exhibition hall (applies **also to sound recordings**). Exceptions may be granted on application to the Exhibition Management. Every exhibitor can lift the ban for their stand under the condition that neighbouring stand or visitors are not shown. Please inform the Exhibition Management immediately in case of violations.
